

Mayfield Demographic Data

For monitoring only

The last census was 2011 so all data after 2011 is estimated and is shown in the tables below. Version 1 below is from the UK Office for National Statistics used by ESBC for planning purposes. Version 2 is taken from a different data set (Mayfield Parish data set) from the ONS that includes some additional postcodes within Middle & Upper Mayfield.
